This beautiful, architect-designed villa, totalling 113 sq metres will be located on a private plot of 4000 sq metres of olive grove in southern Pelion. The southeasterly views across the Aegean sea to Skiathos, Skopelos and Evia islands are spectacular.



The proposed ground floor layout of 61 sq metres is open plan comprising:

2-storey Entrance Hallway

 $4.2m \times 2.7m$ – with feature galleried first floor landing.

Dining Area $4.0m \times 2.5m$

Kitchen Area $4.0m \times 2.5m$

Lounge Area $5.0m \times 4.0m$ (extending to $5.0m \times 6.1m$ when including understair area)

Bathroom with Shower and WC

Cloakroom


Open-tread staircase leading to first floor mezzanine of 52 sq metres

The proposed first floor mezzanine has a galleried landing area overlooking the entrance hallway below, leading to:

Two Double Bedrooms each measuring 5.0m × 4.0m

Bathroom with Bath and WC





The house will be tastefully and simply finished, with with bright, airy rooms, beamed ceilings, stone ground floor, wooden upper floor and plenty of built-in concealed storage. Fully-fitted kitchen and a wood-burning stove. The whole aim is to provide a peaceful, comfortable, private haven.

There will be a driveway with ample parking and terraces with shaded pergolas to both sides of the property.

Due to the aspect and topography of the land, this is a very sheltered area with an abundance of flowers, birds and wildlife

One of the advantages of buying offplan is the flexibility in terms of interior layout and size. Subject to negotiation, a choice of fixtures, fittings and interior layout will be available.

The area of Afelianes is particularly pretty and unspoilt. Taverna Eleni is within walking distance - about 5 minutes - it is widely renowned for its truly fabulous food and organic wines www.cntraveller.com/guides/ europe/greece/pelion/where-to-eat), but is not open at the very beginning and end of the summer season. The beautiful beach of Kastri, with its taverna - www.kastribeachpelion.com - is less than 5 minutes drive away. The picturesque fishing village of Platanias is a ten minute drive away and has a couple of mini-markets plus a variety of good tavernas and cafes. It also has a





lovely beach and nearby Mikro beach with its excellent taverna can be accessed either by fishing boat, by foot on a path or by dirt road.



'Charles and Camilla' Beach

There is also a beach, (nicknamed Charles and Camilla Beach) you can walk to, down a steep footpath (not suitable for those who are infirm). In 1998 Charles, Camilla, William and Harry

Southern Pelion is an amazingly beautiful and unspoiled corner of Greece, full of lush forest, wild flowers and wildlife. There are many beautiful, safe, sandy beaches, some with excellent tavernas and the Aegean sea is crystal clear – perfect for swimming.

If you enjoy walking you will love Pelion. It is criss-crossed with footpaths and *kalderimia* — the ancient donkey tracks. A local society is discovering, clearing and maintaining them and they have also produced a map so that you can find them easily. These walks are particularly enjoyable in the cooler months — especially in spring when the countryside is carpeted in wild flowers. If you prefer to explore the countryside on horseback there is a riding school twenty minutes away near Katigiorgis. www.horsebackriding.com.gr.

There are many cultural events in the summer – a three day classical guitar festival in Lafkos, a month of drama and classical concerts in Horto, art exhibitions and the local village festivals – *panigiri*.





how to get here

There are cheap and flexible BA and EasyJet flights every day of the year to Thessaloniki (3.5 hours drive) and Athens (4.5 hours drive).

Between early May and early October there are charter flights to Volos (1.5 hour drive) and Skiathos (10 minute water taxi) in the summer.

The route from Thessaloniki is very easy and pretty – it takes in Mount Olympus and the Tempe valley. Stunning Vergina and Meteora are well worth detours and visits. Greek motorways are empty in comparison with the rest of Europe.
